**Tip of the Month/Know The Law**

# SB 1262 NOT AS IT APPEARS

When Proposition 215 was passed in 1996 allowing Californians to purchase cannabis with the recommendation of a licensed physician, the specifics of how this would be implemented were not addressed. For example, there are no provisions contained therein to protect medical marijuana patients or dispensaries from multiple forms of discrimination, (drug tests, federal raids, prejudiced landlords, etc.) While most dispensaries have high standards and restrictions on the quality of cannabis they will accept from cultivators and therefore sell, no government agency regulates the quality or safety of the products available. Perhaps sensing the change in the political climate, Senator Lou Correa, with the backing of law enforcement groups, is introducing Senate Bill 1262. SB 1262 would put the responsibility of licensing dispensaries and providers on the State Department of Public Health. This bill, however, seems preoccupied with deciding who is an appropriate medical marijuana user and who is not. It aims to limit those who seek recommendations to the counsel of their primary care physicians. Furthermore, it would force the state medical board to audit any doctor who writes more than 100 recommendations a year. The limit of 100 would not make sense for oncologists, who see only cancer patients, all of which would qualify for medical use. Some medical facilities actively discourage resident physicians from writing recommendations. While regulatory measures could be useful, SB 1262 is not the answer. It seems to do more damage to patients' rights than it helps to clarify the laws surrounding medical cannabis in California.

## Magic Beans!

As outdoor cannabis planting season swiftly approaches, it is important to make sure that soil is nutrient-rich. This is the right time to pH test your soil, amending accordingly. One way to amend nitrogen-deprived soil may surprise you. Plant some beans. Growing any member of the legume family will enrich your soil by raising nitrogen levels. Since cannabis loves nitrogen-rich soil, beans are the perfect pre-crop for local cultivators. They are also nutritious and delicious, so enjoy!
