RECIPE OF THE MONTH

Rainbow Pot-sicles

Ingredients:

1 cup sugar

1 cup water

2 tbsp Suspiciously Delicious Power Honey (raspberry or plain)



Directions:

Put the sugar and water in a medium sauce pan over medium heat. Bring to a boil and stir continuously until sugar dissolves. Remove from heat, and stir in the Power Honey to make your own medicated simple syrup. Set aside to cool. Next, prepare and chill each color of your liquid layers. For red, mix 1 cup pomegranate juice with 2 tbsp. of your homemade simple syrup and 2 drops of red food coloring. Use the same amount of simple syrup and food coloring with your juice for each layer. For orange, use orange juice. For yellow, green and blue, use 1 cup of lemonade each. For purple, use the rest of the pomegranate juice. You will need to freeze each layer individually, which takes at least 30 minutes per layer. For example, start with red; once that is frozen, layer the orange and let that freeze, and so on. Allow the final layer to freeze for at least 3 hours. To remove the cup, simply rip and peel off. Eniov!

JUNE CULTIVATING TIP

Thirsty Plants

In June, outdoor cannabis plants are adjusting to their new environments, and spreading their roots. At this time, it is important to make sure that your water source is pH-balanced, and free of chlorine. When your water is pH-balanced, it can provide greater nutrition to your plants. In Santa Rosa, the measured pH of tap water can often be as basic as 9.0. Optimal pH for watering cannabis is somewhere between 5.5 and 7.0. Local chlorine levels in water can also be a problem. Aerating your water by simply leaving it out overnight and allowing the chlorine to evaporate as a gas is an easy fix for this issue. Give your plants good water to drink, and they will reward your efforts!

Tip of the Month/Know The Law

Grow SAFE

Despite threatening legislative bans and regulations in several counties, medical marijuana patients are permitted to grow their own cannabis in most areas of California, provided they observe certain legalities. Cultivators should be aware of local restrictions, regarding number of plants and possession of finished product. In Sonoma County, this means no more than 30 plants per medical recommendation. All 30 plants must be contained within a 10 foot by 10 foot area, with no more than a 10 foot tall canopy. In the city of Oakland, guidelines allow for up to 72 plants indoors, in a 32 square foot area. Up to 20 plants are permitted outdoors, with no limitations on the area they occupy. These two jurisdictions have more relaxed cultivation guidelines than most of the areas surrounding them, so be sure that you are growing in accordance with local laws. It is always a wise rule of thumb to have fences that are higher than the height of your plants, and to post your recommendation in the area that you are growing. Do not inform anyone who does not need to know about your grow. When cultivation limits are not specified, it is wise to revert to state limits, which allow for only 6 mature or 12 immature plants, and possession of 8 ounces of finished product.
